Childhood Cancer Ireland offers two educational supports for young people in **2nd – 6th Year** who have or have had a diagnosis of cancer. Both supports are free, fully online, and available to students across the island of Ireland.

Educational Supports Available

Institute of Education

Online Weekly Classes (Sep – June)

The Institute of Education (IOE) is a nationally and internationally recognised secondary school. CCI students can access free part-time courses and grinds for 2nd–6th year, recognising the impact of a cancer diagnosis on school attendance and learning.

ExamRevision.ie

Study Platform

ExamRevision.ie is an online study platform helping Junior and Senior Cycle students revise via video tutorials, curriculum-aligned notes, self-correcting quizzes, past exam questions and model answers. Created by experienced teachers to support independent study.

Eligibility & Key Information

Eligibility:

- Child, Adolescent or Young Adult who has, or has had, a diagnosis of cancer
- Currently enrolled in 2nd – 6th Year of secondary school

Key Information:

- All courses are fully online
- A student applying for IOE weekly classes can be enrolled in a maximum of 2 subjects
- A student applying for ExamRevision.ie study platform will have access to all subjects
- Staff will not be made aware that the student was referred by Childhood Cancer Ireland

Referral Pathway

- Return completed application form to **supports@childhoodcancer.ie**
- Once your application has been processed, you will be asked to choose your subject choices and Childhood Cancer Ireland will then share your details with the Institute of Education, who will contact you directly with access details.
- For ExamRevision.ie access, Childhood Cancer Ireland will share access details directly with you.
